  1) In Tea business the value of consumption of raw materials includes green leaf purchased from the parties. As the production of green leaf (Raw 1) In Tea business the value of company for manufacture of Tea) is also from the Company's own estate and involves integrated process having various stages as nursery, planting, cultivation etc. their values at the intermediate stages could not be ascertained.
- Segment Reporting as defined in Indian Accounting Standard-106 is not applicable since the operation of the Company relates to only one segment
  i.e. "Manufacturing and Sale of Tea".
- 3) The above Unaudited Financial Results for the Quarter ended 30th June, 2022 were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors of the Company at their respective meetings held on 12th August, 2022.
- 4) Limited Review of the Unaudited Financial Results for the Quarter ended 30th June, 2022, as required under Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 has been carried out by the Statutory Auditors of the Company.
- 5) This Statement is as per Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and are in compliance with the Indian Accounting Standards (IND-AS) notified under the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 as amended by the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) (Amended) Rules, 2016
- 6) The Company has assessed internal and external information up to the date of approval of financial results while reviewing the recoverability of assets & financial resources, performance of contractual liability & obligations, ability to service the dott & liabilities. Based on such assessment, the Company expects to fully recover the carrying amount of the assets and comfortably discharge its debt & obligations. Hence, the management does not envisage any material impact on its financial position. However, it will continue to closely monitor any material changes to future economic condition as the COVID-19 situation continues to evolve in India and globally.
- 7 In Pursuance of Section 115BAA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 announced by Government of India through Taxation Laws (Amendment) Ordinance 2019, the Company has an irrevocable option of shifting to a lower tax rate and simultaneously forgoe certain tax incentives including loss of the accumulated MAT credit. The Company has not exercised this option in the current period due to unutilised MAT credit available in the books.
- 8 The name of the Company has been changed from SPBF Tea (India) Limited to Durrung Tea Estate Limited with effect from 12th March, 2019 vide Certificate of Incorporation pursuant to change of name issued by the Registrar of Companies (ROC), Kolkata.
- 9 The Company has not appointed a Whole-time Company Secretary as required under the provisions of section 203 of the Companies Act, 2013 during the Quarter ended 30th June, 2022. However the same has been appointed w.o.f 01st July, 2022.
- 10 Balances of Trade Receivables, Other Receivables, Advances, Trade Payables and Other Current Liabilities are subject to confirmation by the parties and include some old items pending reconciliation.
- 11 Figures for the previous period/year have been re-arranged/re-grouped, wherever
